General Tips

- 🐾 3-5 members
- 🐾 Divide responsibilities
- 🐾 Reflect and adjust at the end of each meeting
- 🐾 Be prepared to contribute to the group
- 🐾 Gain appreciation for others' thought processes
- 🐾 Stay on task/redirect when necessary
- 🐾 Create quizzes/study guides that reflect test-level questions
- 🐾 Don't be afraid to ask questions
- 🐾 Study group does not substitute for class
- 🐾 Use resources if additional support is needed on an individual basis (such as tutoring, Supplemental Instruction, and/or academic coaching)
- 🐾 All group members should contribute; find multiple ways for members to participate in the session



Quantitative Courses (*Problem-Based Courses*)

- 🐾 Learn foundations/concepts independently FIRST
 - Read the text, watch videos, annotate notes, review past examples
- 🐾 Attempt to work problems before meeting; bring questions/challenges to the study group
 - Think critically: Focus on 'why' steps are happening instead of memorizing steps
 - Use the session to master each problem type

Do not copy solutions without understanding

Qualitative Courses (*Theory-Based Courses*)

- 🐾 Begin by quizzing each other on basic terms and facts
- 🐾 Progress to explaining whole concepts through writing/drawing/teaching content to each other
 - Critique and proof each other's work
